Subject :- Participation of Junior (Boys & Girls) Indian Yachting Team comprising of 08 Members (05 Sailors and 03 Coaches) in ISAF Youth World Championship 2014 at Tavira (Portugal) during 12th – 19th July, 2014.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. YAI/YWC/2014, dated : 28th May, 2014, on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Government for the participation of Indian Yachting Team, Youth Jr. (B&G) in the ISAF Youth World Championship 2014 comprising of 05 sailors and 03 coach, in 29er Class (2 sailors and 1 coach) in 420 Class (2 sailors and 1 coach) and in Laser Radial (1 Sailor) and 1 Chief National Coach in ISAF Youth World Championship 2014 to be held at Tavira, (Portugal) from 12th – 19th July, 2014, at full cost to the Government, Including Air Passage Cost with incidentals such as Visa Fee, Medical Insurance, Immigration Charges and Airport Tax etc.

2. As per the provision of the scheme, the admissible assistance for Air Passage, Boarding/Lodging etc., would be provided to the above team members and detailed financial sanction for the above will be issued separately.

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3. Section 9 of FC (R) Act, 1976, provides inter-alia that no Member of a legislature, office bearers of a political party, Judge, Government Servant or employee of any Corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without prior permission of the Central Government. In case, any team member is covered under the above Act, he/she should obtain the prior permission from Ministry of Home Affairs before his/her departure to **Portugal**.
4. Such of the team-members who might be Central Government Servants are to be treated as on duty (which include deputation abroad) in respect of this participation by the Department/Office in which they are employed in terms of Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/1/85-Estt. (Pay-I) dated 30.1.1989. The Federation should inform their employing Department/Office accordingly.
5. It is requested that Embassy of India, **Portugal** and Organizers of the event may please be informed by fax of the travel plans and itinerary of the team for participation in the above event. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of views.
6. A report on the visit of the team along with its performance/achievement in the above event may please be sent to this Ministry with 7 days of the return of the team to India along with some action photographs, if possible.
7. Before departure, a report on dope test of the team members may please be obtained from NADA.
