



YAI 38TH HYDERABAD SAILING WEEK 2024 (MULTICLASS RANKING EVENT)

HUSSAIN SAGAR LAKE, HYDERABAD
01st to 07th Jul 2024

Organising Authority

The Organising Authority is the EME Sailing Association (EMESA) & Secunderabad Sailing Club (SSC) in conjunction with the Laser Class Association of India (LCAI) under the sanction of Yachting Association of India (YAI).

1. RULES.

1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS).

1.2 The equipment rules of sailing and current class rules of the competing classes will apply.

1.3 In all rules governing this event, the notations;

1.3.1 **[DP]** denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the jury and may be less than a disqualification.

1.3.2 **[SP]** denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee or technical committee without a hearing, or a discretionary penalty applied by the jury with a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1, A4 and A5.

1.3.3 **[NP]** denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1.4 National prescriptions if any will apply.

1.5 All Indian competitors registered under the YAI, shall comply with the National Code against Age Fraud in Sports (**NCAAFS**).

1.6 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

1.7 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI), the SI shall take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7.

1.8 **[DP]** **[NP]** All prevailing Central and State Government SOPs and protocols about **COVID -19** shall be strictly adhered to by all personnel when ashore. All such instructions will be prominently displayed on the Notice Board.

2. ADVERTISING.

2.1 [DP] [NP] Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

2.2 Competitors may also be required to wear a vest carrying event sponsors names and logos at all times while afloat.

2.3 All competitors and their support team automatically grant the organizing authority and any event sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion of them made at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation. Competitors may be required for media interviews during the period of the event.

2.4 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the organizing authority. Information from such equipment shall not be used by a boat as evidence in a hearing. This changes RRS 63.6.

2.5 [DP] The equipment provided, once placed on the boat as instructed by the organizing authority, shall not be manipulated by the competitor or the support person in any way, except when so required by the organizing authority.

3. CLASSES AND DIVISIONS.

3.1 The event will be organized in the following classes (Ranking) :-

3.2 A minimum of 3 competitors are required to constitute a division as provided in 3.1.

3.3 Participants are required to bring their own boats and equipment.

3.4 Few boats of each class except 470 are available on charter and may be provided by OA, on first come first serve basis, OA may be approached for the same

4. RANKING EVENT. The event approved by the YAI as National Ranking Event as per YAI Policy.

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY.

5.1 All participants and representing Clubs are required to be life member/ annual associate member/ affiliated to YAI & Class Association.

5.2 Entries will be made by filling the entry form and indemnity bond provided at the end of this NOR.

5.3 Competitors and Team leader/Support staff are requested to send the Entry Forms by email before the last date for entry to: emesailing@gmail.com. No withdrawal will be permitted after **18 Jun 2024**.

5.4 Competitors and their support team shall complete an on-site registration at the Race Office. Each team shall be accompanied by the team leader, who may complete the registration on behalf of the team with all necessary documents. The on-site registration of each competitor will not be completed until the measurement form issued by the Technical Committee has been submitted to the Race Office.

5.5 Competitors under 18 years of age shall provide a signed parent consent form. The Form is provided at the end of this NOR.

6. ENTRY FEE.

6.1 The entry fee for the championship is as follows:-

Note: 50% concession in entry fee is applicable for women participants as mandated by the YAI and this is not applicable for the late entry fee and mixed category of boats.

6.3 Entry fee includes Water, Lunch, Tea & Snacks on racing days, attendance for select functions / ceremonies. Entry fee does not include lodging and boarding.

7. RACE FORMAT.

7.1 The championship will consist of single series of fleet racing for all classes.

7.2 Men, women, boys and girls may race together, even as positions for different categories may be extracted and be scored separately.

7.3 For all classes and divisions, participants shall race a maximum of 4 races per day, in a maximum 12 race series. Five races are required to validate the championship for each division.

8. SCHEDULE.

8.1 The venue will be open for practice from 25 Jun 2024.

8.2 Competitors briefing will be held at 1100 hrs on 02 Jul 2024 near the regatta office at venue.

8.3 Practice race for all classes is scheduled at 1500 hrs on 02 Jul 2024.

8.4 The Schedule will be as follows:-

8.5 No warning signal will be made after 1400h on 07 Jul 2024.

9. MEASUREMENT / EQUIPMENT INSPECTION.

9.1 Measurement certificates are required for 470 class of boats.

9.2 All boats will be inspected for class rules compliance prior to racing as per schedule mentioned on Notice Board.

9.3 Equipment Inspection Form will be at the Regatta Office. The form has to be duly filled and presented to the Equipment Inspector at the time of Inspection. Registration will be construed as completed ONLY after Equipment Inspection has been passed by the Technical Committee.

9.4 Additional spot measurement checks may be carried out during the Championship.

9.5 [DP] [NP] Equipment shall only be replaced/repared with the written permission of the Technical Committee. Changes afloat may be approved after the race provided that either the Race Committee or the Technical Committee afloat is notified before the next race.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI shall be displayed on the Official Notice Board.

11. COURSES.

The Courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions

12. PENALTY SYSTEM.

12.1 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42, will apply.

12.2 Protest Committee will be formed as per rule 90.

13. SCORING.

13.1 Scoring will be according to the Low Point System of RRS Appendix A.

13.2 Five (05) races are required to be completed to constitute a series for all categories.

13.3 When six or fewer than six (06) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

13.4 When seven (07) or more races but less than eleven races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13.5 When eleven (11) or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst score.

14. SAFETY.

Unless or otherwise class rules allowed, every competitor and support boat crew member shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI. Harness is not a personal flotation device.

15. SUPPORT VESSELS.

15.1 Support vessels shall be registered at the Race Office. No Support Vessel or Coach Vessel shall be allowed in the racing area during the races.

15.2 Support vessel shall display their respective Club flag/white flag bearing the name of the club whose boat they are supporting. No other flags or identification shall be displayed by the support vessels.

15.3 Personnel onboard support vessels are required to wear a life jacket/PFD whilst on water.

16. BERTHING.

Boats will be kept in the assigned boat parking places only at the venue.

17. RADIO COMMUNICATION.

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY.

18.1 Competitor's participation in the championship is entirely at their own risk. Refer RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority/host club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the championship.

18.2 A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing dinghy in open water in all conditions, including strong winds.

18.3 At-fault occurrences to other boats are the responsibility of the competitor. Competitors are not covered by any liability insurance provided by the organizing authority and should provide their own coverage for personal goods and liability protection. The organizing authority recommends that competitors consult their own insurance carriers to ensure they are covered at this event and regarding additional personal liability insurance coverage.

18.4 A competitor is advised to have personal accident and health insurance that covers him while attending the event and while racing.

19. PRIZES.
