NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* 2013 2016(RRS).
- **1.2** The equipment rules of sailing and current class rules of the competing classes will apply.
- **1.3** If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- **1.4** Appendix P of the RRS (Special Procedures for Rule 42) will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising provided by the OA.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event will be sailed in the following classes:-
 - (a) Laser Standard (Men)
 - (b) Laser Radial (Women)
 - (c) 470 (Men)
 - (d) RSX (Men)
 - (e) Hobie 16 (Open)
 - (f) Enterprise (Open)
- 3.2 Eligible boats are to enter by completing the attached form and sending it to INWTC (MBI) by 15 Oct 15. Entry forms may also be sent by email to inwtcmumbai@gmail.com by 15 Oct 15. All fees are to be paid at the time of registration in cash. No late entries will be accepted.
- 3.2 All participants are required to be Life Members / Annual Associate members of the YAI. Original membership cards are to be produced at registration failing which entries will not be accepted. All participants are required to get their own boats for the event.

4 FEES

4.1 The entry fee will be as follows: -

Single Handed Classes – 3000 INR.

Double Handed Classes - 5000 INR

4.2 The entry fee includes the price of refreshments and lunch on all days and the event T – shirt.

5 FORMAT

All classes will sail a single series of fleet races each.

6 SCHEDULE

- **6.1** Registration and Measurement from 0900 to 1300 on 18 Oct 15.
- **6.2** Practise race for all classes scheduled at 1500 on 18 Oct 15.
- **6.3** Briefing for competitors will be held at 1730 on 18 Oct 15 at the INWTC (MBI) boat shed.
- **6.4** The Racing Schedule is as follows: -

- 6.5 A total of 10 races per class have been scheduled. Each class is scheduled to sail two races per day but may sail one additional race per day for scheduling reasons.
- 6.6 The prize giving ceremony is scheduled for 1730 h on 23 Oct 15 at the INWTC (MBI).

7 MEASUREMENTS

- **7.1** Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- **7.2** Boats without measurement certificates shall get their boats measured from the official equipment inspector at the site.
- **7.3** Boats may be subject to inspection at any time during the event.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after completion of registration on 18 Oct 15.

9 VENUE

The venue for the event will be INWTC (MBI), Pilot Bunder Road, Colaba, Mumbai - 400005. Maharsahtra, India. The racing areas will be off Sunk Rock Lighthouse.

10 COURSES

The courses will be windward/leeward as described in the sailing instructions.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the Hobie – 16 class, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the two turn's penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty.

12 SCORING

12.1 Five races are required to be completed in each class to constitute a series.

- **12.2** When fewer than seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- **12.3** When seven or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

- **13.1** All support boats are to stay outside the racing areas from the time of the first warning signal for the first class to start till completion of racing.
- **13.2** Support boats will be marked with their club insignia.

14 BERTHING

Boats will be kept in the assigned places while they are in the boat park.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 PRIZES

- **16.1** The winner in each class will be awarded the respective National Trophy. The top three in each class will be awarded medals. Additional prizes may be awarded by the OA.
- **16.2** The trophies awarded are rolling trophies and are to be returned to the OA on completion of the prize giving ceremony.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the championship entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The OA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
