Minutes of meeting held in the chamber of Secretary (Sports) on 30th October, 2018 at 04:30 PM to consider the review ACTC post Asian Games/Youth Olympic Games in respect of "Yachting Association of India" for the year 2018-19.

Secretary (Sports) chaired the meeting. The following officers attended the meeting.



2. Secretary (Sports) welcomed all. He wanted to know the plans of "Yachting Association of India" to perform well in Olympics, 2020.
3. YAI informed that for the first time, India won medals in 49er category in Asian Games, 2018. India won 1 Silver and 2 Bronze medals in the Asian Games, recently concluded. Further, YAI added that if adequate support is provided, India is likely to achieve the target of winning a Bronze medal in Olympics, 2020. Already camps are on at Chennai and Mumbai. In Chennai, Programme is being held for youngsters. Boys would also participate in the qualification tournament for Olympics to be held in Europe in October, 2019.
4. Thereafter, the ACTC proposal of the Federation was taken up for consideration. Component - wise discussion took place. On each component, the justification provided by the Federation was considered in detail. Finally, the ACTC Committee accorded its approval on each component as shown under:-






