ELECTION OF OFFICE BEARERS AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE YACHTING ASSOCIATION OF INDIA

- 1. In pursuance of Article 27 of the YAI General Rules, a Special General Body Meeting of the members of the YAI shall be held at 1500 hrs on 29 November 2016 at Varunika, Chanakya Bagh, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi 110021 to elect the Office Bearers and Council Members for the period 2016 2019.
- 2. The President YAI has appointed Shri Ajit Kumar Sinha, Justice (Retd) as the Returning Officer for the conduct of the elections in accordance with the provisions contained in YAI General Rules and the Election Bye Laws. A copy of the Election Bye Law is enclosed for reference at **Annexure 1**.
- 3. The YAI General Rules entitle "Member Clubs" of the YAI to **ONE** vote each at the General Meetings. Extracts of articles related to Voting Rights, Elections and Eligibility Conditions for Election are placed at **Annexure 2**.
- 4. With a view to prepare the Electoral College as required in Form No 1 of the election Bye Laws of the YAI, all Affiliated Units are requested to provide accurate information of the Office Bearers and return the same to YAI office latest by 09 Nov 2016. The information must be provided as per sample letter addressed to President YAI placed at Annexure 3. Please note that the information must be provided on the letter head of your Association/Club and should bear the official seal of the Association/Club.

- 5. On receipt of the information, I shall prepare the list of authorised representatives of the "Member Clubs" and circulate the list so prepared by me to all Member Clubs, latest by **10 Nov 2016**, through display on the YAI website www.yai.org.in.
- 6. For the nomination of a candidate for the post of Office Bearers and Members of the YAI Council in accordance with article **24.3** of the YAI General Rules, at least four Affiliated Units of the YAI (whose names appear in the electoral college) are required to nominate a candidate in the prescribed format placed at **Annexure 4** and each of the nomination paper is to be personally submitted to the Returning Officer by the candidate himself / herself between **16 to 18 Nov 16** (**11.00 AM to 5.00 PM**). The returning Officer shall prepare final list of contesting candidates and display it in a conspicuous place in his office and the YAI website www.yai.org.in by **24 Nov 16**.

- (1) These Bye-laws shall be called the "Election Bye-Laws" and shall govern the conduct of Election of the YAI Council consisting Office Bears and Members.
- (2) In these Bye-laws, unless the contest otherwise requires,
 - (a) "Clause" and 'Sub Clause" mean the clause and sub-clause of these Bye-laws.
 - (b) "Office Bearers and Members" means, Office Bearers The President & Treasurer, Members One Senior Vice President and Eight Vice Presidents.
 - (c) "Form" means the Form appended to these Bye-Laws.
 - (d) "Yachting Association of India (YAI)" means Name of the Federation;
 - (e) "Post" includes the office of President, Treasurer, Sr. Vice President and Vice President of YAI.
 - (f) "Rule" means the rule of Rules and Regulations of YAI.

3. Manner of Election:

- (1) Office Bearers and Members of Council of YAI Shall be elected by secret ballot except the Hon Secretary General and the Hon Joint Secretary General (s) who shall be appointed by the President.
- (2) Election shall be held at the <u>Annual General Meeting (AGM)/ Special General Meeting (SGM)</u> with the approval of the President in accordance with the procedure prescribed hereinafter, from amongst the representatives of the Affiliated members.

4 Electoral College:

- (1) Each regular Member affiliated to the YAI shall have one vote at the elections of the Office Bearers and Members of YAI Council.
- (2) For the purposes of Sub-clause (1), each affiliated Member shall be represented by <u>one member</u> authorised by the President/ Commodore /Vice President/ Secretary General / Vice Commodore of the affiliated regular Member: however, in case President/Secretary General or Vice President /Commodore / Vice Commodore nominates different person, the person authorised by the President/Commodore shall be deemed to be the duly authorised persons. Irrespective of the date.
- (3) Each regular affiliated member shall intimated the name(s) of their office bearer(s) mention in sub-clauses(2) latest by ______(Day 1): and such intimation shall be addressed to the President/Secretary General of YAI on their letter head duly signed by President/ Commodore /Vice President/ Secretary General / Vice Commodore of that member unit, so as to reach him on or before the aforesaid, date: any change in the name of any office bearers after ______(Day 1) or any intimation received the thereafter shall be permitted only with the approval of President YAI.
- (4) The President/Secretary General YAI shall prepare the list of the office bearers of the affiliated Members in Form 1 and circulate a copy of the list so prepared by him to all members, latest by (Day 2), by display, on the YAI website.
- (5) The President/Secretary General shall also furnish a duty authenticated copy of the list mentioned in sub-clause(4) to the Returning Officer as soon as may be after his appointment by the President YAI under clause (5) below.

5. Returning Officer:

As soon as may be before/after the issue of the Notice for the Annual General Meeting (AGM), the President YAI shall nominate a person as Returning Officer for conduct of Election of Office Bearers and members of YAI Council in accordance with the provisions of these Bye-laws.

6. Nomination of Candidates :

- (1) Only Life Associate Members of the Association are eligible for nomination.
- (1) The nomination of a candidate for election as Office Bearer or Member of the Council shall be made in **Form 2**.
- (2) The Nomination of a candidate for election as Office Bearer or a Member of Council shall be proposed by four of the affiliated Members whose names are included in Electoral College list in **Form 1**.
- (3) Each candidate shall be entitled to be nominated by not more than 2(two) nomination papers.
- (4) Each Nomination Paper Shall be Delivered Personally to the Returning Officer in Person by the candidate himself/herself (Day 3) to (Day 5) between 11.00 and 5.00PM.
- (5) No person shall be eligible to nominate more than one candidate for the same post and , if he so does, his/her signature on the nomination papers delivered second in point of time to the Returning Officer shall be deemed to be inoperative.
- (6) No person shall be permitted to withdraw his/her name as proposer, once the nomination paper subscribed by him/her has been delivered to Returning Officer.
- (7) As soon as may be after 1.00P.M on (**Day 7**), the Returning Officer shall prepare a list of all nominations received by him, post wise, in **Form 3** and publish the same in a conspicuous place in his office and the YAI website.

7. Scrutiny of Nominations;

- (1) On **(Day 8) at 11.00 A.M.** The Returning Officer in his office shall scrutinize each nomination paper, one by one, received by him, and determine its validity or otherwise.
- (2) At the scrutiny of nominations, each candidate or one of his/her authorised representative shall have the right to be present and raise any objection in relation to nomination of a candidate for the post which he /she has filed his/her nomination.
- (3) As soon as may be after the scrutiny of all nomination papers has been completed by him, the Returning Officer shall prepare a list of validly nominated candidates in **Form 4** and the Contesting Candidates can take a copy of from the Returning Officer.

8. Withdrawal of Candidatures:

(1) Each candidate whose nomination has been found valid on Scrutiny shall be entitled to withdraw his/her candidature, from (Day - 8) to up to 1.00 PM of (Day - 10)

- (2) Notice of withdrawal of candidature shall be submitted in **Form 5**, either by the Candidate himself/herself or by a person duly authorised by her/him in writing.
- (3) Notice of withdrawal of candidature shall be final and shall not be allowed to be cancelled.
- (4) The Returning Officer shall accept the notice of withdrawal if he is satisfied as to the geniuses of the notice.
- (5) As soon as may be after on the (Day 11), the returning Officer shall prepare the final list of contesting candidates in Form 6, display a copy of the said list in conspicuous place in his office and on the YAI Website. And also furnish a copy of the same to each of the candidates/their authorised representatives, if they so demand.
- (6) The names of the contesting candidates in **Form 6** shall be arranged, for each post, in alphabetical order according to English alphabets.

9. Uncontested Returns: and Contested Elections

- (1) Where the number of contesting candidates for any post or category of post, in **Form 6** is equal to the number of posts to be filled, all such contesting candidates shall be deemed to be duly elected un opposed to those posts, and it shall not be necessary to take a poll for election to such post.
- (2) Where the number of contesting candidates for any post or category of post, in **Form 6** is more than the number of posts to be filled, poll shall be taken by secret ballot for those posts remaining unfilled.
- (3) The ballot papers for these posts remaining unfilled shall be in **Form 7 to Form 10** to be made individually for each post.
- (4) The names of contesting candidates on the ballot papers shall appear in the same order as in **Form 6.**

10. Poll:

- (1) The poll for the Posts Remaining Unfilled under clause 9 (2) above shall be taken post wise on (Day 16) and shall commence during the AGM / SGM at the Agenda Item Elections, at the Venue of the elections).
- (2) Each contesting candidate can nominate one person, (if he/she so desires) only from amongst the Authorised Representatives present at the Poll (Polling station).
- (3) At the poll, each affiliated Regular Member, whose name is included in the Electoral College list in Form 1, shall be entitled to –

- (i) Cast one vote for each of the posts remaining unfilled, where only one such seat is Filled.
- (4) Each voter shall be required, before he is supplied with a Ballot paper, to give his/her signature on the authenticated copy of the Electoral College list in Form 1 used by the Returning Officer for taking the poll.
- (5) The voter shall record his/her vote on the ballot paper in secrecy in a voting compartment specially provided for the purpose at polling station.
- (6) The voter shall record his / her vote on the ballot paper by placing a tick mark $(\sqrt{})$ against the name of the candidate of his/her choice, and any other mark like (x) etc. or placed on the ballot paper by him / her shall render the ballot paper liable to rejection.
- (7) The tick mark to indicate the vote shall be placed by the voter only means of article specifically provided for the purpose by the Returning Officer, and a ballot paper marked otherwise by means of any pen, ball point pen, etc. by the voter shall render the ballot paper liable to rejection.
- (8) The ballot paper marked by a voter shall be deposited by him/her in a ballot box specially prepared and sealed by the Returning Officer and placed at such a conspicuous place in the polling station that it shall be constantly visible to all present in the polling station.
- (9) The Returning Officer shall close the poll at the appointed hour, however, all those voters who are present at the polling station at the appointed closing hours shall be entitled to vote event if the poll proceedings have to be continued for some more time.
- (10) After all the voters referred to in sub-clause (8) have voted, the Returning Officer shall close the ballot box and shall not permit thereafter any person to vote.
- (11) Polling will be done in below order:
 - (1) President
 - (2) Treasurer
 - (3) Senior Vice President
 - (4) Vice Presidents

11. Counting of Votes:

(1) The Returning Officer shall take up the counting of votes as soon as may be after the polling for any post is complete.

- (2) Each contesting candidate can nominate on authorised representative and He / She shall be entitled to be present at the place of counting of votes.
- (3) The Returning Officer shall take up the counting of votes, post wise where applicable.
- (4) Each ballot paper on which a vote has been recorded in accordance with subclauses shall be treated as one vote for the candidate for whom it has been validly marked: and if any ballot paper has been marked in violation of any of the aforesaid provisions of sub-clause shall be rejected by the Returning Officer.
- (5) The votes validly cast for each of the contesting candidates shall be counted post-wise, and category wise where applicable, and recorded in the descending order of the votes so cast for each candidate in Form 14.
- (6) The Returning Officer shall thereafter ascertain the result of counting and, subject to the provisions of Rule 4 (a) (II) of the Rules, the candidates who have secured maximum no. of votes in the said descending order, post wise where applicable, equal to the no. Of seats to be filled for each post or category of posts, where applicable, shall be deemed to have been duly elected to those posts.

12. Declaration of Results:

The names of contesting candidates who shall be deemed to have been elected at the election in accordance with sub-clause (6) of clause (11) shall be declared as having been duly elected to their respective posts, by the Returning Officer at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) / Special General Meeting (SGM) in the Form 15.

PART 5

VOTING RIGHTS, ELECTIONS AND ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ELECTION

23. VOTING RIGHTS

- 23.1 To provide and ensure equality of representation among the Affiliated Units, each member except Individual Members of the General Assembly shall have one vote at the Annual or Special General Meeting of the Association.
- 23.2 An Affiliated Unit wishing to attend any general meeting of the Association must appoint in writing a delegate or representative to attend on its behalf and to exercise all its rights to vote. A true copy of any such appointment shall be delivered to the Honorary Secretary General prior to the opening of the meeting.
- 23.3 Any two representatives of an Affiliated Unit who may be the President / Vice President / Secretary General / Commodore / Vice Commodore shall be entitled to attend the Annual/Special General Meeting of the Association, however, only the delegate so appointed as at 23.2 above, shall be entitled to vote. The nomination of an authorized representative shall be signed both by the President and Secretary General or the Commodore and Vice Commodore of the concerned Affiliated Unit. Any nomination which is not signed by both the President and Secretary General or the Commodore and Vice Commodore of the Affiliated unit concerned, shall not be accepted by the Association. The right of exercising the vote shall vest only in the authorized representative of the Affiliated Unit. In case of any doubt or dispute in relation to an authorized representative, the case shall be submitted to the General Assembly for final decision at the commencement of the meeting.
- An appointment to attend and vote for a general meeting shall be valid for that meeting and any adjournment or reconvening of that meeting only.
- 23.5 Voting at any Annual or Special General Meeting of the General assembly will normally be by show of hands, unless 1/4th of the members of the General Assembly present demand otherwise. The elections of office-bearers and members of the Council shall always be held by secret ballot.

- 23.6 Unless otherwise provided in these General Rules, the decisions at any meetings of the General Assembly meetings shall be taken by a simple majority of the members of the General Assembly present and voting and the required quorum is met.
- 23.7 In case of tie, the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote in addition to his own vote, except in the case of elections of office-bearers and members of the Council.
- 23.8 Voting by proxy or by post shall not be allowed at any meeting of the General Assembly, including the voting at elections of office-bearers and members of the Council.

24. ELECTIONS

- 24.1 All members of the Council, Committees and Sub Committees shall be individual members of the Association and are not entitled to vote.
- 24.2 Only Life Associate Members of the Association shall be eligible for holding an office or to serve on any of the Committees / Sub Committees approved by the Council.
- 24.3 Elections for the positions of President and members of the Council shall be held every three years at the time of the Annual General Meeting. Candidates for these positions shall be nominated in writing by at least four Affiliated Units of the Association. The nominations shall be delivered in writing at least 30 days before the Annual General Meeting. If there is only one valid nomination for a position then the person so nominated shall be deemed to be elected as from the date of the Annual General Meeting or from the date of nomination. If the number of nominations exceeds the number required then an election shall be held.
- 24.4 The Honorary Secretary General and Honorary Joint Secretary General (s) will be nominated by the President from amongst members of Affiliated Units.
- 24.5 (As proposed in AGM 2016) In the event of an Annual General Meeting not taking place in a year, the officers of the Association then holding office will continue in office till an Annual General Meeting does take place or a Special General Meeting is held for the purpose of elections. However, the term of the officers of the Association should not extend the period prescribed in the General Rules of the YAI.

25. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ELECTIONS TO COUNCIL

- 25.1 To be eligible to be elected as an office bearer or member of the Council, a person:
 - (a) must be citizen of India;
 - (b) must be in full possession of his/her civil rights;
 - (c) must not be an office-bearer or member of the Managing Committee of any other National Sports Federation, except that he may be an office-bearer or member of the Managing Committee of any Affiliated Unit or of the Indian Olympic Association or any International Federation;
 - (d) (As proposed in AGM 2016) if he/she is a government servant, must produce a 'No Objection Certificate' from the government under whom he/she is serving for the time being, except that such a government servant shall be eligible to contest election as an office-bearer or member of the Council only for one term or three years whichever is less;
 - (e) must not be convicted of an offence and sentenced to imprisonment for a period which would disqualify a person from contesting an election to Parliament and such disqualification will continue to operate for a further period of six years from the date of release from prison;
 - (f) must not be facing a charge framed against him by any Court in India, in respect of an offence which on conviction would attract disqualification under clause (e) above. If any elected office-bearer or member of the Council becomes disqualified after his/her election under clause (d) or (e) above, his/her seat as such office-bearer or member in the Council shall be deemed to have become vacant on the day he/she becomes so disqualified.
- 25.2 Any office-bearer or member of the Council or of the Committees or the Sub Committees shall be less than 70 years of age on the day of their election and in case anyone of them attains the age of 70 years after his/her election, he/she will be deemed to have vacated his/her seat in the Council, Committee or Sub Committee on the said date of attainment of 70 years age.

- 25.3 No office-bearer shall be eligible to contest an election as any office-bearer or member of the Council if he has already served as an office-bearer in any capacity for two consecutive terms, except the President of the Association who shall be eligible to hold that office of President for maximum of three terms (including the present term as President), with or without break of cooling off period between any two terms as the President.
- 25.4 Any other office-bearer of the Association who has served for two consecutive terms in any capacity shall be eligible to be re-elected in any capacity after a cooling off period of one term.
